Mayor Watzel asked for nominations to serve as Mayor Pro Tem for 2020. Joel Edwards was nominated again for 2020 and approved by all attending Council Members.

Susan Higginbotham discussed the draft of the 2019 financial statements with the Council. Bay Lake's results of operations presents an excess of Revenues over Expenditures of \$2,217,626 for fiscal year 2019. This is a budgeted increase in fund balance for FY2019. The final statements will be distributed at the next meeting.

Ann Blakeslee introduced Eryka Washington, who joined the District on September 30th as the new Communications Manager and announced that she would be working with the Cities and RCID as well as handling any press related calls.
